Thank you for taking the time to read this, and we look foreword to seeing you on the court!

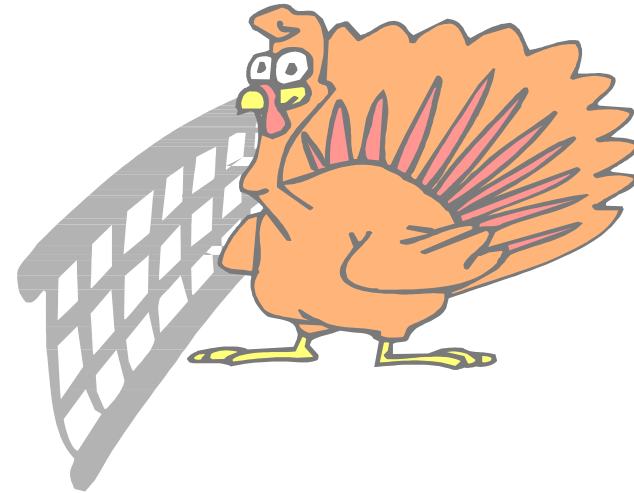
