Purpose of the Post:	To prevent accidents

Responsibilities:

- Ensuring the safety of the facility patrons by preventing and responding to emergencies
- Enforce all health and safety rules established by the American Red Cross
- Enforce all health and safety rules established by the Health Department
- Educate patrons about rules and regulations
- Keep the pool deck and surrounding area clean and orderly
- Monitor pool usage at all times
- Check first aid kit for supplies and replenish as necessary
- Keep accident report forms in the pool binder
- Be prepared to enact the emergency action plan at any time
- Inspect the facility before Family Swim and report all questionable conditions to the MOD
- Keep children out of the hot spa, children under 13 may go into sauna/steam room with a parent
- Complete as assigned, any special assignments as directed by the Aquatics Director
- Participate in all In Service Training
- Attend all scheduled departmental meetings
- Attend quarterly all-team meetings
- Abide by all club/company rules and policies as outlined in Employee Manual(s)
